

AWARD TICKET

Terms and Conditions

Italia Trasporto Aereo S.p.A. ("ITA Airways") and Volare Loyalty S.p.A, respectively the Promoter and Co-Promoter of the Volare and Volare Avventura reward program ("Volare Program"), grant Members, as defined in the Volare Program regulations available at https://www.ita-airways.com/it_it/volare/theprogram/regulations.html ("Regulations"), the possibility to use non-qualifying points ("Points"), earned in the manner and under the terms defined in the Regulations, for obtaining the reward of an air ticket ("Award Ticket"), as better specified in the terms and conditions below ("T&C").

Award Ticket

- 1. Members may obtain an Award Ticket by using Points plus a credit card payment for ancillary charges, including airport taxes.
- 2. An Award Ticket includes:
 - i. the baggage allowance for the travel class booked (e.g. Business, Economy); and
 - ii. any ancillary services chosen by the Member and selected when booking the Award Ticket (e.g. lounge access, class upgrade, extra baggage), as well as those available under the Member's Volare club membership and the travel class selected (e.g. Business, Economy).
- 3. The Award Ticket can be for a round trip or a one-way trip:
 - i. in Economy, Premium Economy and Business class for itineraries with flights operated only by ITA Airways;
 - ii. in Economy and Business class for mixed itineraries (flights operated by ITA Airways and partner airlines) or for itineraries operated by partner airlines only.

The term "partner airlines" refers to the following airlines of the Lufthansa group: Brussels (SN); Lufthansa (LH); SWISS (LX); Austrian (OS).

- 4. In relation to point 3 above, it should be noted that Premium Economy class is only available for some network flights (where the term "network" refers to the type of flight: domestic, international or intercontinental).
- 5. The Award Ticket is personal, non-transferable and non-convertible into money or any other form of monetary compensation. Moreover, it cannot be replaced, refunded or converted into vouchers or credits, except as expressly provided for in the T&Cs.
- 6. It should be noted that taxes and surcharges applicable to the Award Ticket may vary by the time of issuance, by the departure and destination airports chosen, and by the travel class.

How to Apply for an Award Ticket, use of Points and Taxes

- 7. Members may apply for an Award Ticket as follows:
 - i. via a dedicated section in the Member's personal Volare area; or
 - ii. by contacting Customer Care, following the instructions provided at the following link: https://www.ita-airways.com/it_be/volare/theprogram/volare-contacts.html.



- 8. Award Tickets issued through our Customer Care may be subject to a fee, as specified in **Table 8** annexed to the T&Cs. This <u>fee</u> may vary (depending on market trends), is non-refundable, and is payable using the payment methods specified in point 1 above.
- 9. The fee referred to in point 8 above is not applied if the Award Ticket is requested through the ITA Airways website or app.
- 10. The number of Points required to obtain an Award Ticket is specified in **Tables 1-7** annexed to the T&Cs. To this amount are added the Points needed to cover any surcharges applied by ITA-Airways and/or the partner airlines of the Lufthansa group: Brussels (SN); Lufthansa (LH); SWISS (LX); Austrian (OS). The total amount in Points will be visible while booking.
- 11. Award Tickets can be issued both to the holder of the Volare account and to any accompanying persons or beneficiaries upon entering their name when booking the Award Tickets.
- 12. Award Tickets are issued at the time of booking the flight and must be used within 12 months from the date of first issuance.

Travel Class, Seats, Open Jaw Flights and Stopovers

- 13. It is possible to issue an Award Ticket for a round trip, choosing a different travel class per flight segment.
- 14. On each flight, seats assigned to Award Tickets are subject to limited availability.
- 15. The pre-selection of seats on the flight is subject to payment, except for flights operated entirely by ITA Airways, for which the selection of seats may be free of charge based on Volare club membership level.
- 16. Stopovers are not allowed. In the event of a stopover, two separate Award Tickets must be issued.
- 17. Open jaw flights, allowing travelers to fly into one airport and return from another, are not allowed. In these cases, two separate Award Tickets must be issued.

Changing and Cancelling an Award Ticket

- 18. To make changes to an Award Ticket issued, Members will be charged the fee specified in **Table 9** annexed to the T&Cs.
- 19. Changes to Award Tickets may only be requested through Customer Care:
 - i. to obtain a different flight whose amount in Points is equal to or greater than the one already booked;
 - ii. to obtain the following upgrades: **a)** booking class upgrades within the same travel class (e.g. transition from class F to class X in Economy); or **b)** travel class upgrades (e.g. transition from Economy to Premium Economy). Such changes will affect the entire itinerary;
 - iii. Booking class (RBD) or travel class downgrades are not allowed.
- 20. In addition to the above, changing an Award Ticket in terms of the network (where the term "network" refers to the type of flight: domestic, international or intercontinental) is only allowed as per the following table:

- 21. To cancel any Award Tickets issued, Members must pay a fee as stated in **Table 10** annexed to the T&Cs.
- 22. Award Tickets can only be cancelled through Customer Care for each flight segment (outbound and return flight).
- 23. Following a cancellation request, as soon as is technically feasible, the Member's Points balance will be supplemented by the amount of Points used to obtain the Award Ticket.
- 24. Members who cancel an Award Ticket will also be refunded the full cost of any taxes paid, using the payment method indicated at the time of booking the Award Ticket, within a maximum of five (5) days or, alternatively, in accordance with the conditions of their credit institution.
- 25. For an itinerary with flights operated solely by ITA Airways, the price (expressed in Points) of an Award Ticket for children, i.e. passengers between 2 and 11 years of age, and the related penalties for any changes or cancellations, will be 75% of the adult fare. On the other hand, the price (expressed in Points) of an Award Ticket for infant passengers, i.e. passengers aged between 0 and 23 months, and the related penalties for any changes or cancellations, will be 10% of the adult fare. For mixed itineraries, including flights operated by the ITA Airways partner airlines Brussels (SN), Lufthansa (LH), SWISS (LX) and Austrian (OS), these reductions shall not apply.
- 26. Requests for changes or cancellations to goods/services purchased using Points in Award Ticket mode, made by Members after the Volare Program end date as specified in the Regulations, shall be handled as follows:
 - i. **Changes**: requests for changes will not be considered.
 - ii. **Cancellations**: cancellation requests will be considered and Members will be refunded only the amount paid in currency in accordance with the law.



TICKET FARES

The number of Points required to obtain an Award Ticket is indicated in Tables 1–7. To this amount, the Points needed to cover surcharges—applied by ITA Airways and/or possibly by partner airlines of the Lufthansa Group (Brussels Airlines (SN); Lufthansa (LH); SWISS (LX); Austrian (OS))—are added. The total amount in Points will be displayed during the booking process.
